

Delmarva Raptors Uniform Policy

The Delmarva Raptors have a uniform policy designed to maintain a consistent appearance. The Raptors stress the "team" aspect of the game, and this is one way each player can show their commitment to their team and as well as promoting the Raptors organization in the community.

Standard Uniforms

The Raptors standard uniforms shall consist of:

- Two Custom Raptors Game Jerseys-1 Blue and 1 White
- Two pairs of Custom Socks-1 Blue and 1 White
- One Custom Raptors Shell or Black Shorts
- One Reversible Practice Jersey
- Raptors Helmet Decals

Game jerseys shall NOT be worn to practice. The reversible practice jerseys aid the coaches in dividing players for scrimmages and drills; thus, they should be worn to all practices.

Alternate Jerseys

The Board permits individual Raptors teams to create alternate jerseys. Any team wishing to have an alternate jersey for their team must abide by the following rules:

- 1) Submit the design of the alternate jersey to the Board for approval.
- 2) Once approval is granted by the Board, the team may purchase the alternate jerseys.
- 3) Alternate jerseys may ONLY be worn during tournament play unless written permission is requested and approved for a set game or time period. For example, requesting to wear holiday themed jerseys during December.
- 4) Alternate jerseys may NOT be worn during any league games with the DVHL unless written permission requested and approved by both the Raptors Board and the DVHL in advance for said jersey to be worn at specific games.

Miscellaneous Uniform Policies

- 1) All DVHL teams must have a DVHL sticker on their helmets.
- 2) To the extent possible, please remove any previous team stickers from helmets.
- 3) For 12U and up, all players MUST wear a mouthguard during all games.
